An **elopement** is aimed at reaching an engagement or a marriage (not just running off). The goal of an elopement is to force the relatives of a girl or a woman to agree to a marriage with a specific candidate. Often the candidate has earlier been rejected or his marriage proposals are (justly or unjustly) deemed hopeless.


This chart shows which steps a process of elopement usually takes, and in which situations the case may get out of hand. This chart is an indispensable tool for the professional.




Categories Of Conflicts Regarding Honour Based Violence

Of course **blood revenge** and **honour killings** are also included in the chart. Also available in other languages.


