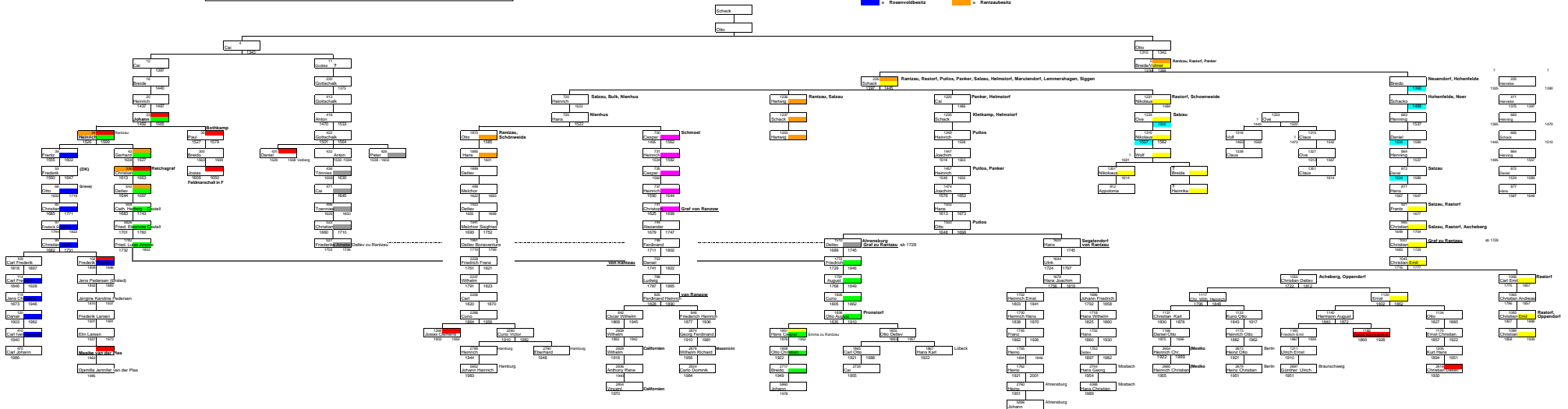

He went to Ceylon, then a Dutch colony. After the Napoleonic wars the English failed to return the colony. As a result the descendants moved to the Dutch East Indies. While there they applied for Dutch nobility under the name of 'van Ranzow'. (Nowadays, however, they use 'von Ranzow') After the 2nd WW, they left Indonesia, part of them for California, the others for the Netherlands. The Americans now use 'Morassow'.	Bredo zu Rantzau is married with Elise Snook (daughter of Hendrik Snook) and into Holsteiner horses.	Henri # 1755 was General in the German anti aircraft artillery during World War II.	Henri # 2760 is busy with solid wood furniture production	The Mexican Occupation	Ulrich zu Rantzau # 1182 (son of Herman August Graf zu Rantzau and Juliane geb. Brockdorff) was adopted by his mothers family Brockdorff after the early death of his father and became famous through his leading role during the negotiations in Versailles at the end of World war I.
