Aircraft of 320 (Dutch) Squadron RAF Bomber Command, crashed on February 9th, 1945, near Tienen (Tirlemont), Belgium, after a mid-air collision 20 minutes after take-off from RAF Melsbroek, Belgium. Collision occurred at approx. 15:20 hours.
